KEY EVENTS

Leaving Certificate Oral Exams

Supervised Study

This will be available to students during the second week of Easter to support their revision.

Notification of Exam Dates

The SEC (State Examinations Commission will notify the school over the next three weeks with specific dates for oral exams. Subject teachers will inform students of all relevant details.

Details for practical exams in Art, Construction, Engineering, and Music will also be forwarded to students by their subject teachers.

Medical Certificates - If a student is absent from a scheduled oral or practical exam, a medical certificate will be required for eligibility for a resit application with the SEC.

Pre-Exam Reports

These will be available from Tuesday, 25th March, reflecting the results returned to date.

Appointments

Where possible, please schedule medical or other appointments outside of school hours to avoid disruption to learning.

Punctuality
